ELECTRIC START TRIMMER

AFFECTS:

TOUCHSTARTTM TRIMMER UT20683

The new TouchStartTM trimmer offers improved performance and durability. We have addressed the problems of the earlier models and the following is a listing of these improvements in order of importance.

1. Problem:

Earlier Models - Engine would not crank fast enough to start.

Solution:

Adjust throttle cable so the throttle lever cam contacts the decompression valve.

Root Cause:

Throttle cable stretch.

TouchStart™: Decompression valve actuated by nonadjustable electric solenoid.

2. Problem:

Earlier Models - Starter switch sticks in start position or fails to make contact.

Solution:

Replace control handle.

Root Cause:

Too complex design. Slide type switch had to manually engage the

decompression valve and then make electrical contact to activate the starter

motor.

TouchStart™: Rocker switch does both functions electrically.

3. Problem:

Earlier Models - Did not start easily or quickly when hot and was difficult to

start after fueling.

Solution:

The only solution was to prime using the start assist bulb.

Root Cause:

Choke was prevented from closing when unit was warm.

TouchStart™: Choke control arm has been modified to allow the choke to close any time the engine is stopped. The idle speed has been raised to 4500 RPM to prevent the

choke from closing at idle.

4. Problem:

Earlier Models - Unit was not well balanced, engine appeared to be too heavy.

Solution:

Trade for TouchStart[™].

Root Cause:

All of the weight of the battery was located directly under the engine.

TouchStart[™]: Battery relocated forward of the throttle trigger, closer to the front handle for better balance and feel. Additionally, this location provides the battery a much

lower vibration environment and will extend battery life.

5. Problem:

Earlier Models - Semi-automatic feed heads frustrates users and is a source of

dissatisfaction with line trimmer.

Solution:

Convert to new Pro-Cut^R head which feature .105" diameter DuraLineTM

cartridges. This is the simplest to use string head on the market.

Root Cause:

Lack of understanding of how semi-automatics string head works.

TouchStartTM: Standard equipment includes the Pro-Cut^R string head. For those customers

who desire the e-z-lineTM advance system, they may purchase it as an

accessory. It does not require any special adapters.



In Parts List PS00085 and PS00394 on page 5, the carburetor part number UP00609 for clutch units was omited. The carburetor listed UP00021 is for non-clutch units only. (The difference is UP00021 is a fixed HI jet single needle type and UP00609 is a fully adjustable dual needle type.)

In Parts List PS00394 on page 2, *the drive connector part number 08990 for TrimLiteTM*, *EasyTrimTM and Trim N' EdgeTM was omitted*. The drive connector listed part number 98795A fits the EasyReachTM and PhantomSSTM. (The difference is 08990 measures .210" across the square and 98795A measures .250" across the square.)

In Parts List PS00394 on page 12, the locking hex nut part number 98837 for the VersaToolTM should be 81282.

Under extreme operating conditions it is possible for the fuel tank to expand and contact the engine shroud. Continued operation with this condition could result in a fuel leak developing at the point of contact.

The fuel tank has been modified with two reinforcing ribs to prevent the expansion. A foil reflective tape has also been added to reduce the heat conductivity of the tank and lower the overall operating temperature. See Figure 1.

All affected units should be updated to the new tank configuration. All customers should be contacted for repair of affected blowers in their possession. The enclosed notices should be posted at your service counter to alert customers of the situation.
